

## IIDA Texas Oklahoma Chapter Education Fund Study Abroad Program Scholarship

### Award Description & Terms

- Each year one Study Abroad Program Scholarship is awarded for \$3,000 to a qualifying student. The Texas Oklahoma Education Fund Committee may elect not to award the scholarship due to lack of qualified submissions or lack of interest.
- Recipient agrees to present a verbal/visual presentation at the IIDA TX OK Student Conference or other approved Chapter Event and to provide a digital copy of the presentation for Chapter use.
- **The scholarship funds will be paid directly to the student; split in two payments, \$1,500 upon award and \$1500 following recipient's Chapter presentation.**
- Scholarship recipients will be recognized at the Annual IIDA TX OK Student Conference IIDA TX OK Chapter will cover financial obligations for recipient to attend the Conference including travel expenses, one night's lodging and Conference attendance fees.

### Eligibility

Applicants must meet ALL of the following requirements:

- Current IIDA Member
- Enrolled within the Texas Oklahoma Chapter's jurisdiction as a Junior or Senior in an undergraduate program with Council for Interior Design Accreditation (CIDA) or graduate program.
- Declared Interior Design (or related) Major with a cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Study Abroad Program must be part of a University or other structured curriculum
- Shall not be a previous recipient of this scholarship

### Submission Requirements

Complete Packets shall consist of original Recommendations and Transcripts with all other requirements submitted digitally:

- **University Transcript** bearing the embossed seal of the institution
- **(2) Letters of Recommendation**  
Letters must be sealed and signed by letter author across the seal. One letter must be from university professor within the Interior Design Department, the second letter may be either from a professor or professional design practitioner.
- **Application**  
Complete the attached application form and attach a current photograph in the space provided.
- **Statement of Interest**
- Provide a one page typed 300-word maximum narrative of personal goals and visions. Discuss the relevance of study program to you studies in Interior Design. The ability to articulate your reasons for wanting to enhance your education through study abroad will be an important factor to the jury committee's decision.
- **Verification/Description of Course Curriculum**
- **Proposed Budget** submit an itemized financial outlay of expenses including, but not limited to: airfare, room and board, tuition, supplies, etc.
- **Resume** provide dates for the following:  
Work Experience: internships or other work experience supporting the student's college education  
IIDA Service: Provide IIDA membership and involvement, noting positions of leadership  
Campus Involvement and Community-wide Service: List membership in activities, noting positions of leadership  
Honors & Achievements: Scholarships & Awards
- **Student Portfolio** submitted digitally for disc or flash drive consisting of a sample of work.

### Selection Criteria

The Texas Oklahoma Education Fund Committee will review all complete submissions and selections will be made at the sole discretion of the selection committee along with IIDA Texas Oklahoma Chapter Board approval.
