Attention: All those intending to take the NCIDQ

With the new Interior Design law there are new processes for applying to take the NCIDQ. All Interior Design candidates are required to register with the State of OK for approval to take the NCIDQ examinations. The OK application can be found on the Board of Governors website:

- **Those intending to take the Spring NCIDQ exams**, your OK application and \$75 fee is due at the BOG office by 4:30pm, October 1, 2007.
- **Those intending to take the exam *this Fall*** were suppose to submit their application to the State by March 1st of this year. This information was not readily available and has created a great deal of confusion and angst.

Jean Williams, Executive Director of the OK Board of Governors, has extended the deadline. The application and fee must be on her desk *ASAP* to meet NCIDQ's August 10th deadline.

Be certain to include your fax number if you want Jean to fax your approval notice to you.

Take caution – any application omissions or errors will cause the application to fail to meet the stated deadlines. In that case, the application will be continued to the next examination schedule.
